Dear Valued Customer,

The Candidate List of 163 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC substances) subject to authorization has been published by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) on its website and was updated last on June 15, 2015 in accordance with Article 59 (1) of REACH Regulation. In that regard, we would like to confirm to you that such SVHC substances are not intentionally present above 0.1 % w/w concentration in the following products:
